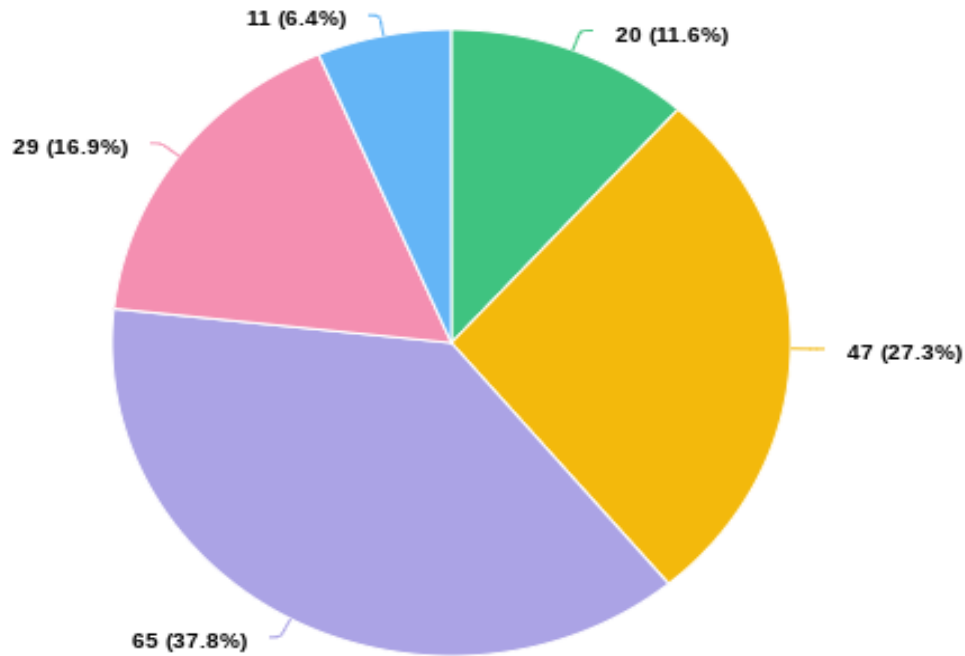


## Adult Carers survey initial high level results

- 229 responses so far.
- 44.8% caring for an elderly person (over 65).
- 43.7% caring for an adult (up to 65 years old).
- 17.2% caring for a child with a disability or long term illness or condition.
- Deadline extended to 31 October.



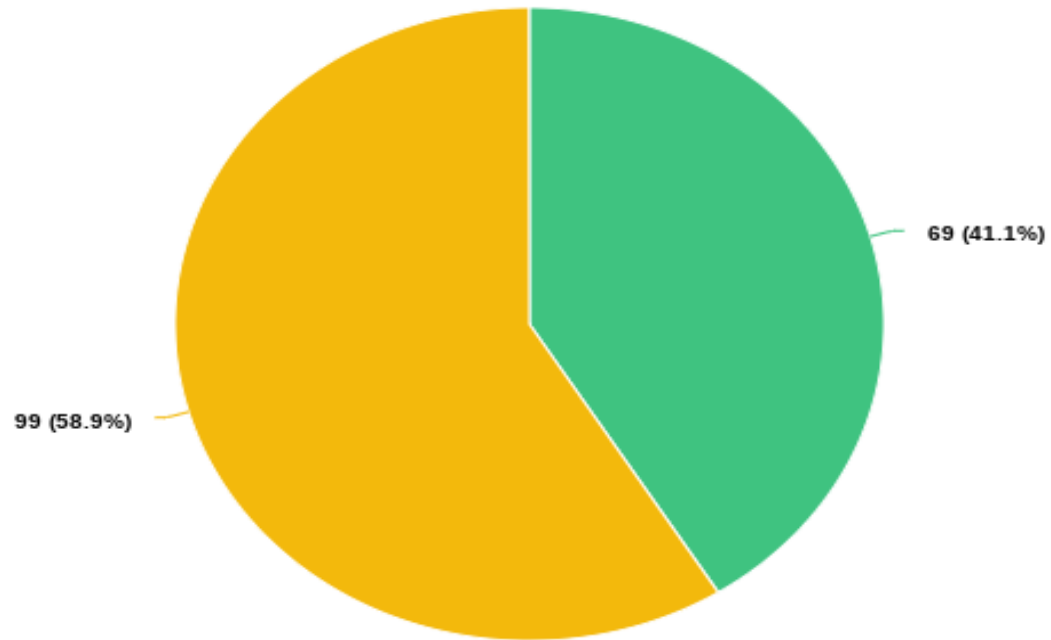
Q8 How would you describe the support for carers in the Royal Borough of Kingston?

Q15 Have you had a carers' assessment done to consider your own needs and support?

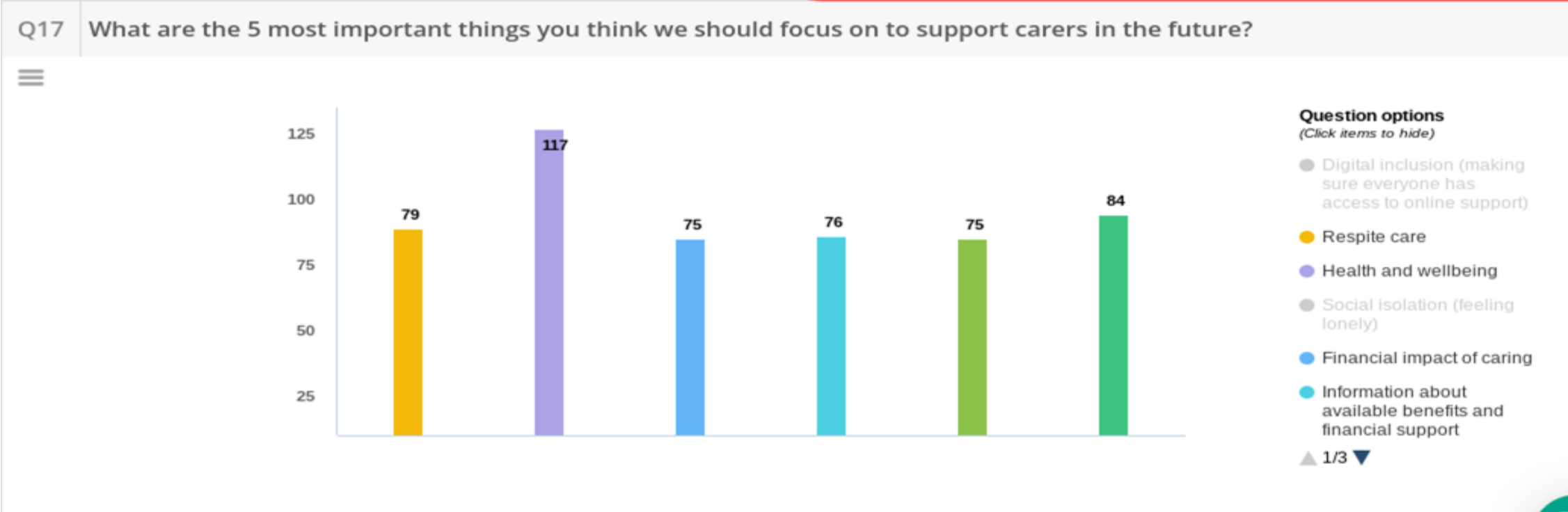
